

Annual Meeting of the Claverack Free Library

The annual meeting of the board of trustees of the Claverack Library will be held on Tuesday, June 15th at 6 p.m. The meeting is open to the public and will be conducted both in person and through videoconference via Zoom. The library is now open for browsing, having continued to serve the community during the year-long health crisis through the provision of online materials, curbside pickup, and virtual programming.

Additionally, the FRIENDS are holding ongoing weekly themed book sales inside the library and a raffle of three extravagantly filled gift baskets.
